

Basic Firearms Instructor School

July 13 – 17, 2009

Instructors: Sheriff Kevin Erickson, Luce County. Sheriff Erickson has been a firearms instructor for most of his law enforcement career. He has trained at the Federal Firearms Training Academy and has taught extensively at the recruit and in-service levels for the past 15 years.

Course Description: A 40 hour program designed to provide the student with training on how to administrate an in-service firearms training program. In addition to accurately evaluate and correct student errors as it relates to, sight alignment and trigger control. Sections on legal and moral use of deadly force will be addressed. The need to incorporate low light shoots, stress courses and shoot don't shoot decision making will be discussed and demonstrated. Range safety will be a daily factor while the instruction phase is in process.

Specialized Equipment Required: Students are required to bring their duty weapons, shotgun and rifle. Web gear for the duty weapon and extra magazines are also required. Students will need 1000 rounds for duty weapon, 15 rounds shotgun slugs, 15 rounds double 00 buck, and 50 rounds of rifle ammunition.
