

# Precision Driving Update Iron Mountain, MI

**Two four hour sessions (8:00-12:00 OR 1:00-5:00)**

**Instructors:** Mike Bath, MSP Certified Precision Driving Instructor, Public Safety Institute and State Certified Range Technicians.

**Course Description:** A four hour program which includes one (1) hour of classroom instruction covering laws pertaining to law enforcement personnel, along with vehicle dynamics. Three (3) hours of range instruction utilizing state approved courses, incorporating pursuit driving and decision making as to whether to continue or not continue a pursuit situation. The participants will also be exposed to the basics of vehicle dynamics and maintenance.

**Location:** **Ford Airport, Woodward Avenue just West of Westwood Avenue. (former ISD building at the airport)**
