**Course Description:** A two-day school, 12 hours per day from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm. A police officer's ability to deter impaired drivers is directly linked to detection (i.e. the ability to recognize clues of impairment), for without that skill, there is no deterrent. The seminar covers everything from the detection of an OUIL driver, to contact, sobriety tests, report writing, legal arena, and courtroom testimony. There is an emphasis on Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus training. Live drinkers will be used during the training.
