Course Description: This program is designed to prepare a department to implement a Use-of-Force Management Program by developing better managers who are able to: create a road map for managing the use-of-force, train better officers, instill confidence in officers to properly do their jobs safely, assess the needs of their agencies, conduct complete, thorough reviews of UOF incidents, how to take corrective action if needed and the fostering of community trust.

Course Topics: Constitution/Bill of Rights, Relevant Case Law, State Statutes/Administrative Rules, Relevant Regulatory Training Standards, Dept. Policy & Procedures, Dept. Training Programs, UOF Advisory Committee Development, Deposition & Courtroom Testimony, Incident Reviews, Responses & Announcements, Subject incident, dept. debriefing, conducting incident debriefing session, incident scene management, scene documentation, tracking UOF incidents, how to review UOF incidents, what LEO's can do in UOF incidents, generating agency buy in, citizen interaction & support.

Who should attend: All criminal justice system personnel involved in the management of force. Agency heads, first line supervisors, middle level managers, command staff members, all instructors, dept. investigators, FTO's, line officers, internal affairs personnel, PIO's, policy writers, legal counsel, risk managers, state/post training standards personnel, prosecutors and judges.

Cost: \$495. due at time of registration. The training has a 50/50% matching MMRMA Risk Avoidance Program (RAP) grant for the first 25 MMRMA members that sign up. 25 MMRMA members will be reimbursed \$250 upon successful completion of the course. The cost for Non MMRMA members is \$495. **MCOLIS 302 funding approved. Meals & Lodging not included.**

Class size: Limited to the first 35 registered and paid.
